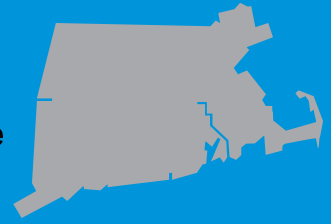

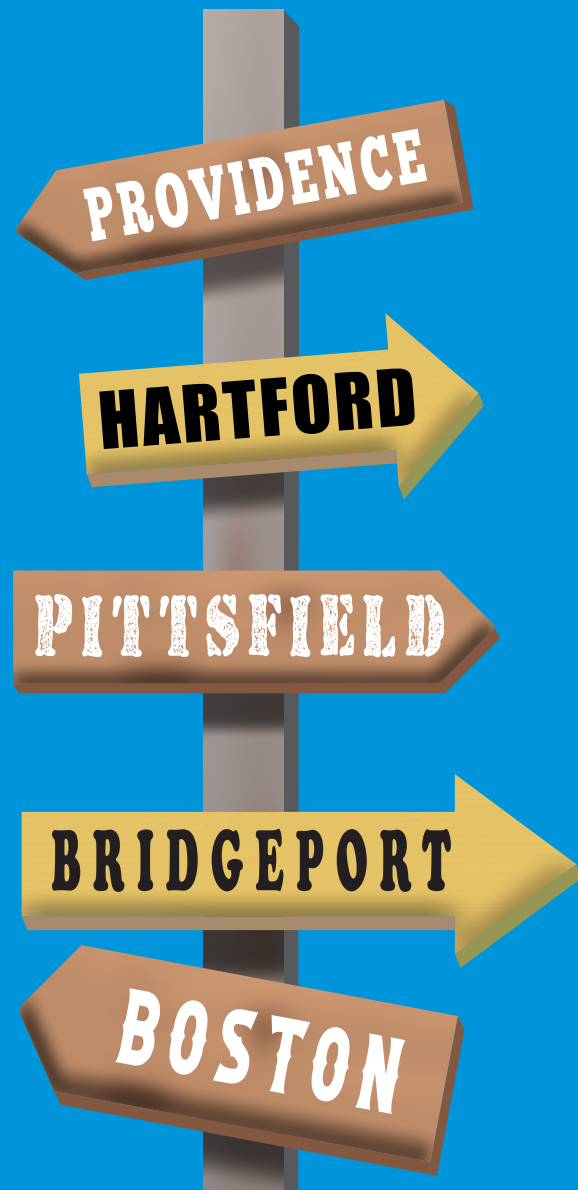

What an honor and blessing SNEC has given to me to serve as Executive Secretary and HR Director for the past 3 years. At times, the work has been exhausting and invigorating, it has all been worthwhile to take part alongside our Constituency in growing the kingdom of God. During the past 4 years, from 2017-2021, our conference has been truly blessed and I would like to take the opportunity to share the statistical report.

At the beginning of the 35th quadrennial from 2005-2009, the total membership of SNEC was registered at 15,487. At the end of the 36th quadrennial from 2009-2013, it was registered at 16,724 for a net gain of 1,237. At the end of the 37th quadrennial from 2013-2017 the total membership as of July 2016, was at 18,434 for a net gain of 1,720. At this quadrennial from 2017-2021 as of December 31, 2021, we were at 20,120 for a net gain of 1,686 or 9.15%. Our membership growth rate has increased in each of the last 4 quadrennials.

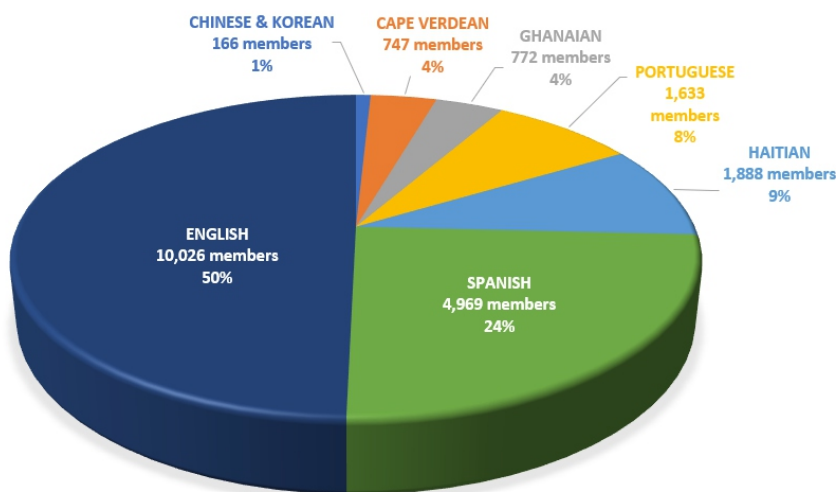
In sharing this report, I want to acknowledge with profound gratitude the dedication of every director and their respective departments, pastors, teachers, office staff, ABC employees, Camp staff, church members that gave their time and resources in caring and loving the many people in our territory.

In the past 4 years our congregations have increased from 142 to 152 churches as of 2021. As of June 30, 2022, we now have 154 churches and companies. Praise God from whom all blessings flow!

We have a diverse conference with 12 different language groups representing English, Spanish, French, French Creole, Portuguese, Portuguese Creole, Cape Verdean Creole, Twi, Swahili, Korean, Mandarin, and Cantonese.

I cannot express enough how dedicated and committed our Administrative Assistant to the Secretariat Margie Santos has been, aka the boss! Most of our Conference church clerks have been trained in eadventist and procedures pertaining to the position.

We have been assisted by Glorimar Teixeira who has trained our Spanish speaking clerks and has provided additional help where needed.

A special thank you to the Education, Treasury, Youth, Trust Services, and Ministerial Departments for helping with HR related work.

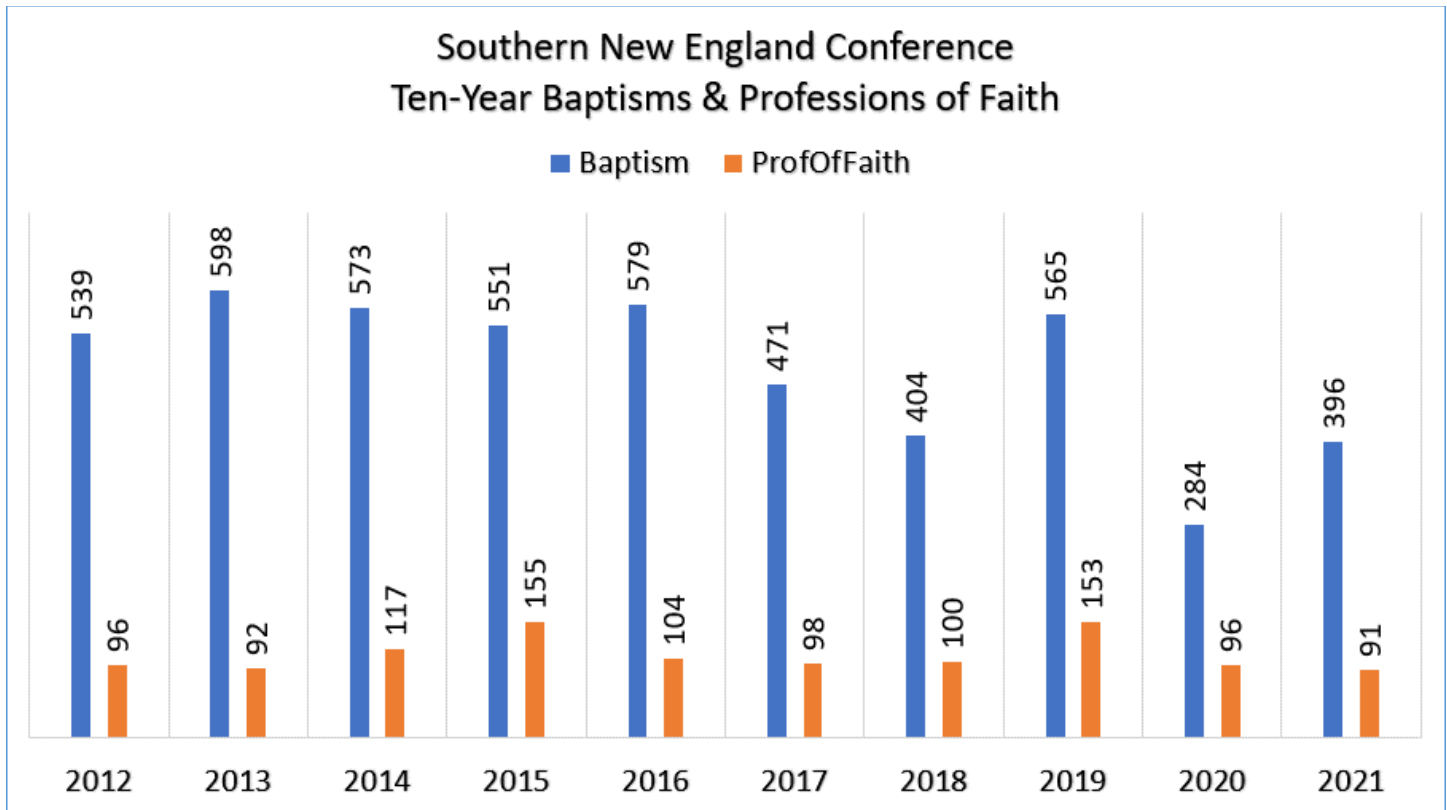
Church Planting
