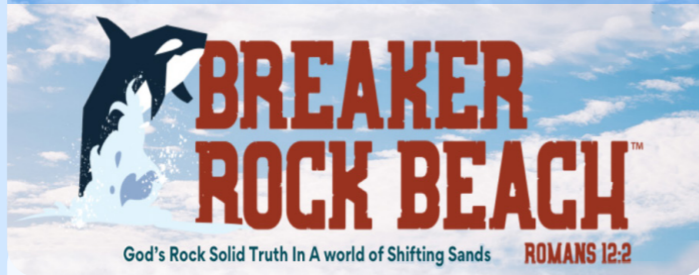

Registration Process: New Check In/Out System

- **Check In/Check Out Process**
- Applies to Kindergarten, Primary, and Junior departments, including nightly evening programs.
- A parent/guardian must drop off and pick up children in these divisions.

General Guidelines

- **Pets** are not permitted on the campground (except service dogs).
- **Quiet time** begins at 10:00pm, Gates will close at 10pm.
- **Lost and found** is at the Locating Tent.
- **Missing child:** Contact front gate.
- **First Aid** trailer located near Bailey Hall.
- **Parking** is in designated areas — no sleeping in cars or parking lots.
- **Parents & guardians of children** — you are personally responsible for the supervision of your child(ren) at all times.
- **All attendees** are expected to dress modestly.
- **Alcoholic beverages, smoking, illegal drugs, and fireworks** are not permitted on the campground.

Child Protection Statement Church Participation Agreement Policy

Registered Sex Offenders (RSOs), those CONVICTED of a sexual offense with a minor, and other PARTICIPANTS* must obtain a Participation Agreement with the Southern New England Conference before they are allowed onto the campground for Campmeeting programs.

A Participation Agreement with a local church does not qualify as a Participation Agreement for Campmeeting. Additionally, a Campmeeting agreement from last year will not qualify for this event.

As part of the Participation Agreement RSOs, those CONVICTED, and other PARTICIPANTS will not be allowed to stay on the campground overnight.

RSOs, those CONVICTED, or other PARTICIPANTS discovered on the campground without a current Participation Agreement with SNEC will be asked to leave.

Those wanting to start the Participation Agreement application must contact Pastor Edgardo Herrera, Executive Secretary, or April Montoya-Gonzalez, Child Protection Coordinator at (978) 365-4551.

*PARTICIPANT—a person that has admitted to or is known by process of church review to have creditable accusations of sexual misconduct, which has been reviewed by the SNEC Child Protection Committee.

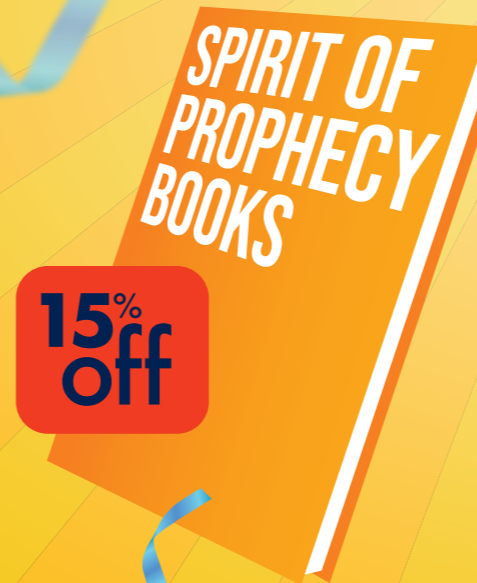
